
### Sound:

- 1. At the top of 1.1, the gonfalon fabric fell off the tearable gonfalon upon its placement into the boardwalk. Mr. Henri immediately picked up the fabric and carried it around with him during the scene and held it up taut at the end of the line for Mr. Murphey to grab from him. It was a good save on stage! We believe the actors simply caught the fabric with their hands while securing the gonfalon, the fabric had been tied correctly.
- 2. The blood seemed to be very sticky tonight and proved difficult to disperse on stage.
- 3. The handoff of Mr. J. Johnson's cleaned sword in Act 2 was 2 scenes late but was still able to make it on stage. It has been addressed with crew and stage management and will not be an issue moving forward.
